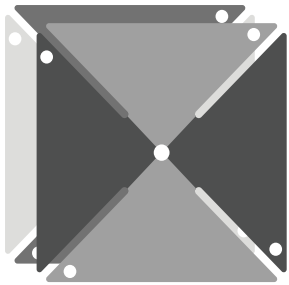


# build a pinwheel

pinwheel (1 page)



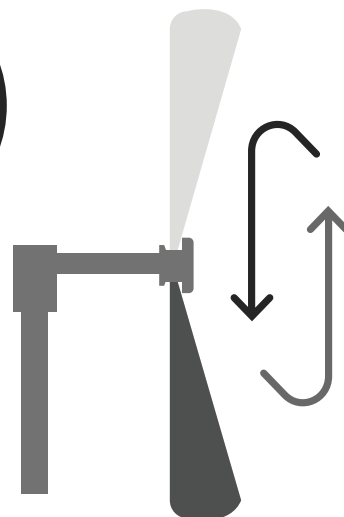
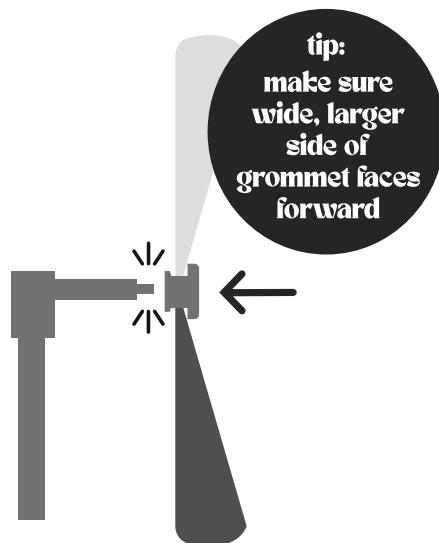
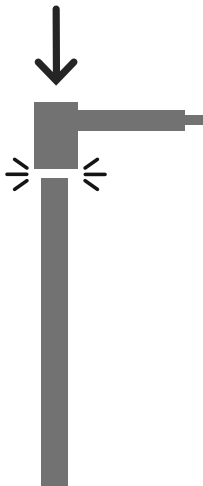
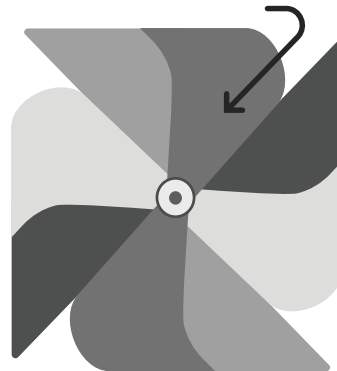
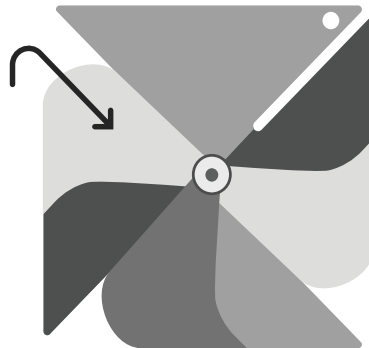
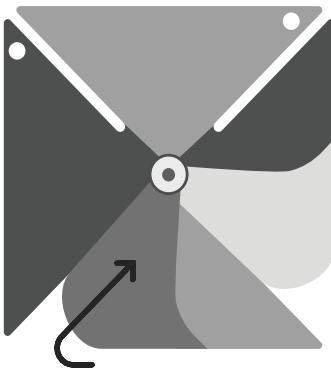
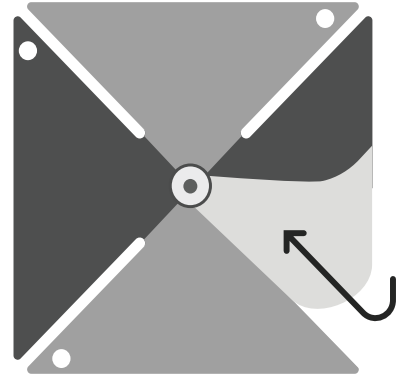

# pinwheel instructions:



1. Download and print a PDF template. Decorate one or both, sides of the paper with markers or colored pencils.
2. Cut along lines indicated by dotted line.
3. Fold every other point into the center dot and put a paper fastener through the paper. This step can be tricky because the points like to escape if you're not holding them tightly.
4. Hold the paper fastener with gathered points in one hand and use your other hand to push the remainder of the pin through the straw or popsicle stick. Once your paper fastener is through the straw, bend the pieces to make a T.

**TIP:** Make sure when you're securing the paper fastener that you're leaving some space for your pinwheel to spin.

5. Give it a spin!
