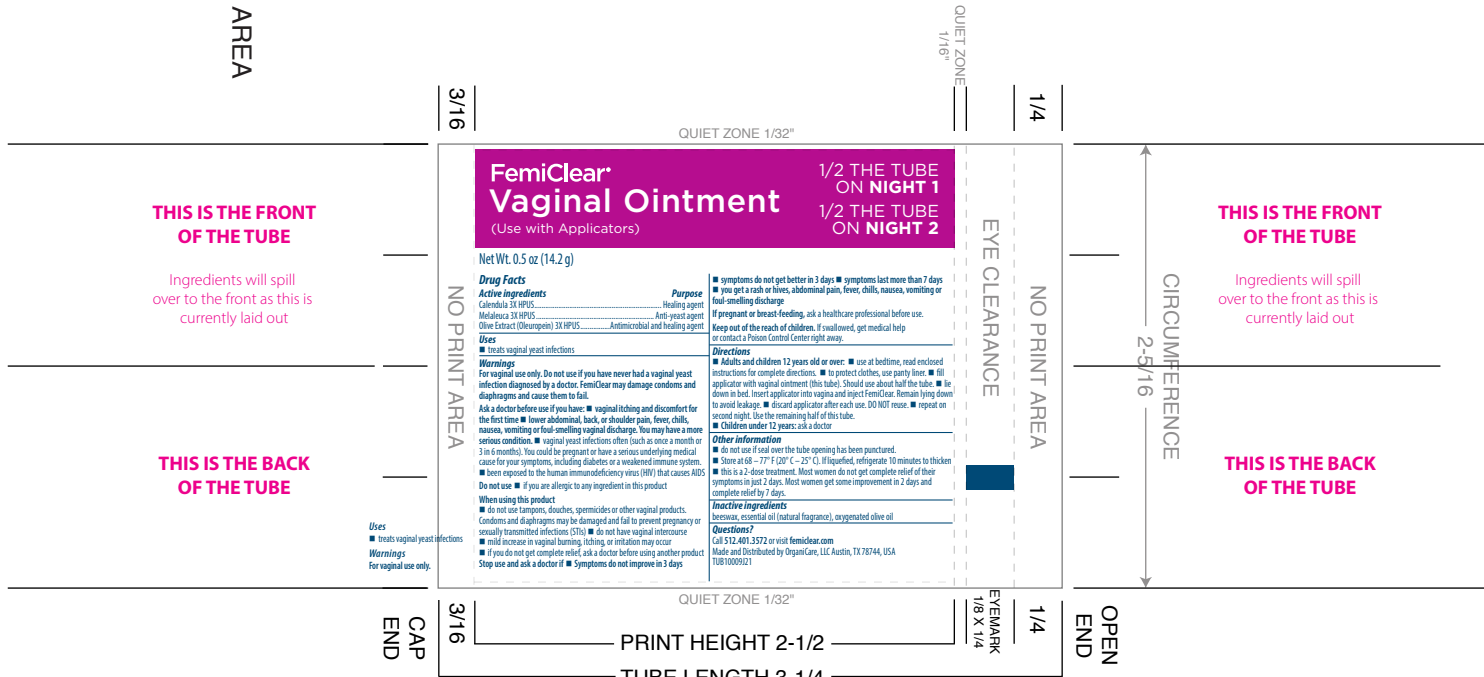

Warnings
For vaginal use only. Do not use if you have never had a vaginal yeast infection diagnosed by a doctor. FemiClear may damage condoms and diaphragms and cause them to fail.
Ask a doctor before use if you have: ■ vaginal itching and discomfort for the first time ■ lower abdominal, back, or shoulder pain, fever, chills, nausea, vomiting or foul-smelling vaginal discharge. You may have a more serious condition. ■ vaginal yeast infections often (such as once a month or 3 to 6 months). You could be pregnant or have a serious underlying medical cause for your symptoms, including diabetes or a weakened immune system. ■ been exposed to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) that causes AIDS

Do not use ■ if you are allergic to any ingredient in this product

When using this product
■ do not use tampons, douches, spermicides or other vaginal products. Condoms and diaphragms may be damaged and fail to prevent pregnancy or sexually transmitted infections (STIs) ■ do not have vaginal intercourse ■ mild increase in vaginal burning, itching, or irritation may occur ■ if you do not get complete relief, ask a doctor before using another product

Step up and ask a doctor if ■ Symptoms do not improve in 3 days

■ symptoms do not get better in 3 days ■ symptoms last more than 7 days ■ you get a rash or hives, abdominal pain, fever, chills, nausea, vomiting or foul-smelling discharge

Keep out of the reach of children. If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions
■ Adults and children 12 years old or over: ■ use at bedtime, read enclosed instructions for complete directions. ■ to protect clothes, use panty liner. ■ fill applicator with vaginal ointment (this tube). Should use about half the tube. ■ lie down in bed. Insert applicator into vagina and inject FemiClear. Remain lying down to avoid leakage. ■ discard applicator after each use. DO NOT reuse. ■ repeat on second night. Use the remaining half of this tube. ■ Children under 12 years: ask a doctor

Other information
■ do not use if seal over the tube opening has been punctured.
■ Store at 68–77° F (20° C–25° C). If liquefied, refrigerate 10 minutes to thicken

■ this is a 2-dose treatment. Most women do not get complete relief of their symptoms in just 2 days. Most women get some improvement in 2 days and complete relief by 7 days.

Section 1: Identification

Section 2: Hazard Identification

Classification: Not classified as hazardous under OSHA Hazard Communication Standard (29 CFR 1910.1200).

Hazards: May damage condoms and diaphragms. May cause allergic reaction in sensitive individuals.

Precautionary Statements: Avoid contact with eyes. If allergic reaction occurs, discontinue use and seek medical advice.

Section 3: Composition/Information on Ingredients

Active Ingredients:

- Chamomilla; CAS 8002-66-2; 0.1% – Anti-itch and anti-inflammatory agent
- Olive Extract (Oleuropein); CAS 8060-29-5; 25.9% – Antimicrobial and healing agent

Inactive Ingredients:

- Beeswax; CAS 8012-89-3; 8%
- Colloidal oatmeal; CAS134134-86-4; 5%
- Olive Oil; CAS 8001-25-0; 59%
- Essential Oils (unspecified blend); CAS N/A; 2%

Section 4: First-Aid Measures

Inhalation: Not applicable under normal use conditions.

Skin Contact: Discontinue use if irritation occurs. Wash affected area with soap and water.

Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth and contact a Poison Control Center immediately.

Section 5: Fire-Fighting Measures

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Use water spray, dry chemical, carbon dioxide, or foam.

Hazards: Combustible organic ingredients may ignite if exposed to open flames or high heat.

Protective Equipment: Firefighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and full protective gear.

Section 6: Accidental Release Measures

Personal Precautions: Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged skin exposure.

Environmental Precautions: Prevent entry into waterways and drains.

Methods for Cleanup: Wipe up with absorbent material and dispose of in accordance with local regulations.

Handling: Use as directed. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash hands after application.

Flash Point: > 200°F (estimated based on oils)

Solubility: Insoluble in water; soluble in oils

Section 10: Stability and Reactivity

Stability: Stable under recommended storage conditions.

Reactivity: No dangerous reactions known under normal conditions.

Conditions to Avoid: Excessive heat, open flame.

Incompatible Materials: Strong oxidizers.

Hazardous Decomposition: Carbon oxides may be released under fire conditions.

Section 11: Toxicological Information

Likely Routes of Exposure: Skin contact, eye contact, accidental ingestion.

Acute Effects: May cause skin irritation in sensitive individuals. Eye contact may cause irritation. Ingestion may cause gastrointestinal upset.
