8.2. Exposure controls

Appropriate engineering controls:

- **Professional /Industry Workers** : Due to the many possible conditions of exposure, the user should consider the actual period of use of a chemical protection glove to be significantly shorter than the period prior to permeation. 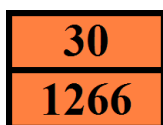
